Lynn University NFT and Fine Art Exhibits – Created by the Eugene M. and Christine E. Florida Atlantic University (FAU) Department of Visual Arts and Art History – FAU Alumni Exhibition featuring the work of six artists who are graduates of the Fine Arts Program at FAU. Entrance 4950.

Dorothy Gillespie Gallery – In partnership with the Boca Raton Museum of Art, Dorothy Gillespie's works are pure visual pleasure; particularly Celestial Presence, an ambitious environment of more than 350 hand-painted and hand-formed aluminum starburst sculptures exploding with color and pattern, located in the JAVA coffee shop in the 4950 building.
